**RESOLUTION AND RULE PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING OF
COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES, CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT,
CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, OR DEBRIS ON DISTRICT ROADS AND ROAD
RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED: Pursuant to HB 847, 2001 Legislature, codifying Chapters 75-374, 79-461 and 84-430, Laws of Florida, the Governing Board of the Dog Island Conservation District, at public meeting on July 6, 2002, adopts the following resolution and rule:

1. No commercial motor vehicle, construction equipment, or construction materials or debris shall be parked or placed overnight on the roads or the road rights-of-way maintained or controlled by the District within its boundaries.
2. This prohibition shall not apply to the parking or placement of such vehicles, equipment, materials, or debris in the District's shop area, when such are used to perform work for the District.
3. The District may institute a proceeding in a court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin any person or entity from violating this prohibition.

Resolution adopted by vote of the DICD Board of Directors, July 6, 2002 and to become effective immediately.
